If you walk to school, always walk the designated route. Sidewalks and lighting are provided for your safety.

Cross only at the designated crossings. Whether it be at the traffic light, crosswalks, or with the assistance of a crossing guard.

Never assume drivers see you-make eye contact with drivers before walking in front of their vehicles.

Always watch for turning vehicles and do not step in front of vehicles that are too close to stop safely.

Do not run or ride bicycles or skateboards in crosswalks.

Wear reflective clothing when walking when it is dark.

When provided, always use the pedestrian push button.

If riding the bus, always follow the bus rules.

If driving always be aware of your surroundings especially in school zones.
