Approval of October Meeting Minutes

Safe Walking Routes – Lego League Project Possibilities (5 min)

- Three students from Lego League attended to explain their team's theme "City Shapers"
- Team to address the safety issues of crosswalk near the church parking lot in front of Arcadia
- Idea brainstorm (ideas must be able to be implemented by the kids):
 - o Awareness/education campaign
 - o Bold/bright reminder signs, bright t-shirts, 3D/bright markings on the road
 - o Ideas cannot regulate the church too much or the church will be liable and have to shut down parking access
- Final long-term strategy will likely be a team effort between Arcadia teachers, Crossing-guards, Lego League, Student Council, and community professionals such as Detective Lloyd
- Keep the traffic flow issues in mind for the future reconstruction of Arcadia. Look into ideas from others schools (e.g., West Valley, Truman).
- Kids to come back and present their final ideas soon for approval.

Grade Reconfiguration meeting at Bennion - Brandalyn (5 min)

- Dec. 4th will be the grade reconfiguration townhall
 - o Bennion Principal Mary Ann Stevens to present what Bennion will look like if 6th grade and 9th grades move up. Also will address parent questions.
 - o The meeting will be streamed on Facebook Live

- Ben Horsley from district also did an informational meeting from Taylorsville HS that is posted on their Facebook website. (Video correction: there will 14 relo. buildings needed, not 6-8).
- Process: Survey goes out to the community in January. Results in 2-3 weeks. Community councils will review the results, then more meetings will be scheduled to complete the changes if approved.
- 2021 is soonest changes could be made.
- Rising construction costs are delaying rebuilding projects around the district.

- The Hexagon Tool – used to guide selection of issues and evaluate potential programs
 - o Plans using this tool have an 80% success rate over 3 years, while only 14% success rate if this model is not used or used ineffectively
- Land Trust Fund usage possibilities: Behavioral Health Specialists, Art curriculum, Small-group specialists for breakouts, character development classes, Substitute teachers so teachers can give their own progress reading DIBELS
- Other:
 - o Arcadia interested in learning how to become a STEAM school
 - o Arcadia Parents Night in the future: include budget review, PTA kickoff, and community council overview
