Safe Technology and Digital Citizenship assembly – How did it go?

- Toothpaste analogy used: can't put what you post online "back in the tube" so be aware of what you put out there. Use it to be kind, uplifting.
- Common Sense Media – a resource for parents, students, and teachers
- Practice with kids what TO DO online, not just what not to do
- Teachers could imbed teaching safe technology practices into their lessons regularly
- Community Council may need to look into additional training resources for teachers

- Smart Boards (\$1200 each and \$150 install)

- Community Council additional responsibilities are: Safe-Walking Plan, Digital Safety
- Post minutes of meetings for the public one week before the next meeting (Mr. Graham also to help with sending out an email of minutes to parents).
- Send regular letters to the Legislature detailing how funds are being used to improve student achievement and how the plan is working

Start next year's SSAP brainstorm (10-15 min) – Social worker discussion

- Our Student Achievement Plan for Arcadia is due in March 2020
- Look at DIBELS to address student needs next meeting- will be used to help write our achievement plan
- Land Trust funds to be used for academic reasons, not for “school climate” or “behavior” – Some schools have used their funds for social workers. How can this meet an academic need? Mr. Graham to look into this for next meeting.

How is our School doing discussion (10 min)

Some students have struggled to adjust to a new school (from the Oquirrh Hills school closure). There has also been some great successes with the transition.
