# Social worker discussion continued/ Mr. Graham's findings Other ideas if social worker is not an option

- Health is one of the options for goals for the SSAP plans
- How can progress be charted on emotional/mental/social health?
  - One idea: Office referrals recorded in Educators Handbook
- Mr. Graham waiting to hear back from administrators that he contacted who have full time social workers
  - Need to determine total cost of salary and benefits for a fulltime social worker (roughly \$45,000+)
  - How their social workers fit into their overall academic plan

### Look at available dibels M.O.Y. test scores (10-15 min)

- District counts 60% of students at Benchmark or Above Benchmark as proficient.
  - The district would like schools to reach 80% proficiency

- Arcadia school average proficiency (Benchmark or Above Benchmark) at beginning of year: 54%
- Arcadia average proficiency at middle of year: 56%
- Arcadia currently uses small group instruction and programs such as Lexia for reading progression
- Resources that we can educate/pass along to families for reading practice at home:
  - Sora online reading resource
    - Begin by informing parents of Sora at SEP conferences
  - Upstart pre-k reading program
  - Libraries offer 1 free hour of tutoring per day with a children's library card sign-up
