Grade reconfiguration input on student transition - Taylorsville Network SCC rep. Maria Miles (20min)

Input given by council members was more towards district transparency to the community on their desires and plans for Taylorsville Network, and towards the 6<sup>th</sup> grade teachers being affected by the reconfiguration in Taylorsville Network. It seems that the statements from the district level prior to reconfiguration approval was that the affected teachers will have a placement in the new grade configuration, but it seems now after the approval that this is not so much the case, or at least the process for current 6<sup>th</sup> grade teachers to have a sure placement where they want to be is not as certain, and is requiring more time and effort than was transparently expressed in the community hearing prior to reconfiguration approval.

Maria Miles will share our concerns and input to the district community council meeting in January, in hopes it can reach the ears on the district's level that can improve district-community trust and communication.
