-Focus: Reading Goal: to raise DIBELS scores by the end of the year by 3%

- Strategies:

- DIBELS testing (beg, mid, end of yr)
- Explicit routines and direct instruction in classrooms
- Will use the Wonders program for direct instruction and modeling
- Dyad reading for grades 2-5th
- Phonics Template (sound recognition and speed) for K-1st
- Heggerty program K-1st
- Graphic organizers will be used to improve writing
- Teachers will review tests and data to inform them of needs
- Firm up Tier 1 & 2 reading interventions
- Schedule paraprofessionals in small groups with students (under teacher direction)
