## Report on Council Roles ( 5 min) -All Members

- It was a small group last month, just want to go over the roles and any questions council members may have.

## District Community Council Update ( 5 mins)- Jenn Hathaway

- Update from November DCC meeting

Jenn Hathaway attended the DCC meeting. The majority of the meeting was regarding the new early warning system called Panorama. H.B. 404 was passed in 2017 which "provides for systems to identify students in need of early intervention". Panorama Education was awarded the contract to pilot an Early Warning System. The purpose of the program is to provide early intervention to students and reduce the percentage of students with course failures and chronic absences.
It is currently available to a few High Schools and Jr. Highs in the district but it will become district wide in March/April. Also, LAND Trust wording was updated to help fund for Panorama.
Also in the meeting they discussed Net Safety and dispersed a flyer "Do you know what's on your child's phone?"

## Data Review/Testing (10 min)- Mr. Graham

- Middle of year Acadience testing began December 1st Mr. Graham provided data regarding Middle of the Year (MOY) testing and there is an increase in scores. Mr. Graham explained that it is typical to see MOY scores go down for $2^{\text {nd }}$ grade due to what they are tested on (phonics vs. whole words). Mr. Graham has posters up in his office for teachers to review the scores and discuss ways to help. Testing for math will be coming.
Grades 3-5 are participating in RISE practice tests.
WIDA testing- for multi-lingual learners will be in mid-March. Mr. Graham shared that Flip Grid is being used with the multi-lingual learners where they are recording themselves talking. This is to help with test results. Finally, they are
using Imagine Learning daily for our multi-lingual students. This is an interactive and adaptive program to help the students in their learning.
Last, Mr. Graham shared that Common Formative assessments, which are informal assessments, are given to every student.


## LAND Trust Budget Committee Report (10 mins)- Mr. Graham

Mr. Graham provided information on the budget, currently have spent $\$ 16,688$, which leaves $\$ 42,312$ to be used by June. The money currently is being used to staff para professionals.

## After School Tutoring Partnership Report (5 mins) -Christina Belcher

- Provide any updates to the tutoring partnership opportunity. We were able to partner with Taylorsville High Latinos in Action (LIA) students. Tutoring will happen after school for 45 mins starting January $11^{\text {th }}$ through May. Mrs. Paras will host. Arcadia students were identified through the WIDA testing (those that scored a 11.5). 10 multi-lingual students were invited to attend the tutoring. If tutoring is not full with these 10 students, then selected students that scored a 1.5-2 in WIDA testing will be invited.
