#### Data Review/Testing (10 min)- Mr. Graham

- o Mr. Graham announced that the superintendent will be visiting the school on April 24, 2023.
- o EOY testing for kindergarten will be on May 15th
- RISE testing- Reviewed benchmark data for grades 3-5. Students continue to do practice tests.
- Attendance data:
  - Last year's attendance average was 92%-93%
  - Current year attendance average is 80%
  - It is a district wide problem
- o Professional Learning Data:
  - Math: 5 trainings
  - Reading: 4 trainings
  - WIDA: 3 trainings
  - RISE: 3 trainings
  - Data Analysis: 4 PL times
  - Other: 7 trainings
- o Behavioral Data:
  - Office and Minor referrals are down substantially from 21/22 to 22/23 school year.
  - Minor referrals were included in CIP goals.
  - Aggression and KHYFOOTY are the trending offenses for Office referrals.
  - Aggression and disruption are the trending offenses for Minor referrals.
- o iREADY Diagnostic Assessment Data:
  - MOY testing data is trending positively
    - Intensive (Red): 34 %
      - o BOY Intensive (Red): 45%
    - Strategic (Yellow): 52%
      - o BOY Strategic (Yellow): 48%

- Proficient (Green): 14%
  - o BOY Proficient (Green): 7%
- Lowest scoring concepts: Geometry/Measurement & Data
- WIDA Test Average Scale Scores coming soon

#### LAND Trust Budget Committee Report (10 mins)- Mr. Graham

- Current budget- remaining funds will be used to pay for paraprofessionals and after school tutoring.
- o Mr. Graham requested a quote for new microphones for 25 rooms
- 2023/2024 budget will focus primarily on paraprofessionals. The remaining budget will be used for tech/equipment and \$600 will go towards the NetSmartz assembly.
