I hope you and your family are having a great summer! I'm looking forward to welcoming our students back to school on August 16th. School begins at 8:40 a.m. and gets out at 3:20 p.m. Monday – Thursday. On Fridays/early out days, school lets out at 1:15 p.m.

Arcadia Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP)



In our CIP, we have three areas of focus for which we have goals to work towards. They are:

ACADEMC GOALS

Goal 1: Upper grade students will increase RISE Test proficiency rates in Reading by 7%, in Math by 6%, and in Science by 5% by the end of summative testing.

Goal 2: All students will increase Acadience Reading and Math proficiency rates by 6% working towards 70% overall proficiency by the end of the school year.

SOCIAL SKILLS & DISPOSITIONS GOAL

Goal: As a school, we will reduce the overall number of behavior referrals by 7% by the end of the school year.

BACK TO SCHOOL MORNING

Instead of having Back to School Night, we are having a Back to School Morning on the first day of school (August 16th). This will be a time to meet with your child's teacher and view the classroom. Teachers will speak to parents in groups as individual conversations cannot take place due to time constraints. If you would like to have a prolonged conversation, you can email the teacher to set up another time to meet. Parents will also be able to sign important documents and learn how to access the parent portal during this event. Please check out the PTA and Community Council table and consider joining. TALENT DEVELOPMENT GOAL

Goal: Teachers will collaborate 98% of the time at least eight times each month to review student data and strategize on how best to help all students progress towards proficiency in all subjects by the end of the school year.

Parents and all stakeholders play an important part in helping us succeed with our CIP goals. Please ask your child's teacher how you can help.

PAYING FOR BREAKFAST & LUNCH



If you would like to pay for breakfast and/or lunch, please do so online by clicking on the PayPams picture above. Students and parents may also pay for meals in the office by filling out an envelope. On the envelope is a receipt. Please be sure to take it and write your child's name and teacher on the front of the envelope. A box is in the office where you can drop your payments. If you are struggling financially, please apply for free/reduced meals. Breakfast is \$.90 a day and

likely will not receive important information from the school. Please check with a secretary to make sure we have your correct email address and telephone number in the system if you're unsure.

PARENT/GUEST PARKING

Parent/guest parking is located in the parking lot on the east side of the building. All students (including kindergartners) should be picked up/dropped off in the designated areas around the parking lot or on the west side of the school in the church parking lot. Please DO NOT park in the loading zones or in the BUS ZONE. If you do, you may be ticketed as we take down license plate numbers of repeat offenders.

STUDENT BUILDING HOURS

Students should not be in the building before 8:30 a.m. unless they eat breakfast or have permission from a staff member. Students who eat breakfast should go to the cafeteria when let in by a supervising adult All other students need to line up outside next to their grade level door until their teacher comes to collect them and bring them inside.

KINDERGARTEN SCHEDULES

Morning kindergarten is from 8:40 a.m. to 11:40 a.m. There is no afternoon kindergarten. On early out days, morning kindergarten is from 8:40 a.m. to 10:40 a.m. Full-day kindergarten follows the same hours as the rest of the school (8:40 – 3:20 / 8:40 – 1:15).
