# Toilet Training



## Helpful Tips



Toilet training is a process. Every child progresses at their own pace, so trust your child's abilities and be patient with the process. They will get there!

1. **Look for Signs of Readiness:** Showing interest in the toilet, staying dry for longer periods, understanding basic instructions.
2. **Create a Routine:** Establish a regular routine, including times for sitting on the potty, such as after meals or before bedtime.
3. **Make it Fun:** Some families chose to use positive reinforcement such as stickers, other families may sing songs while on the potty.
4. **Use Child-Friendly Language:** Use simple and clear language to explain the process. Avoid pressure and negativity, instead focus on encouragement and support.
5. **Lead by Example:** Let your child observe you using the toilet to understand what to do. This helps to normalize the process.
6. **Provide Comfort:** Use a child-sized potty or a toilet seat insert to make sitting on the toilet more comfortable and secure for your child.
7. **Be Patient:** Understand that accidents will happen and setbacks are normal. Stay calm, offer reassurance, and avoid showing frustration or disappointment.
8. **Practice Consistency:** Stick to a consistent routine and approach to toilet training. Consistency helps reinforce learning and build confidence.
9. **Offer Encouragement:** Praise your child for every effort, even if they don't succeed every time. Encouragement and positive reinforcement go a long way in motivating your child.
10. **Stay Supportive:** Be supportive and understanding throughout the process. Let your child know that it's okay to make mistakes and that you're there to help them learn.

**Every Step Counts:** Celebrate every small victory along the way! Whether it's sitting on the potty for the first time or mastering the art of flushing, each step forward is a reason to cheer.



**Mistakes are Learning Opportunities:** Accidents happen, and that's okay! Instead of getting discouraged, view accidents as learning opportunities for both you and your child. Offer reassurance and support, and remember that setbacks are a natural part of the learning process. Celebrate each milestone as progress!



**You're Building Confidence:** Toilet training isn't just about mastering a new skill—it's also about building confidence and independence. By empowering your child to take ownership of their bathroom habits, you're laying the foundation for a lifetime of self-confidence and resilience.



**You're Doing an Amazing Job!** Parenting is full of challenges, and toilet training is no exception. Give yourself credit for all the hard work you're putting in and the love and support you're providing to your child. You're doing an amazing job, and your efforts will pay off in the end!

Granite School District wants to support your child in reaching all of their developmental milestones. HB 331, beginning with the 2024-2025 school year, requires a student to be toilet trained before enrolling in kindergarten.

As part of our support to your family, our social workers will provide resources to your family to help you at home to get them toilet trained. We will ensure that your child will be reintegrated seamlessly when they do become toilet trained.

## House Bill 257 “Bathroom Bill”

The Legislature passed a bill stating that people in Utah must use the restroom according to the sex assigned at birth. An infographic is below summarizing the bill.

### HB257 Compliance

Granite School District is committed to following Utah State law, including HB257, 2024 (Utah Code §63G-31-301) while at the same time providing privacy and safety to all members of our school community. To this end, each facility will continue to maintain gender-designated private spaces (e.g., restrooms, locker rooms, dressing rooms, showers). Additionally, each facility will maintain and make available unisex and/or single-use restrooms. If an individual needs access to, or accommodations regarding a unisex or single-use restroom or other private space, the individual should contact school or district administration.

Please understand that Utah law now requires the following:

- **Students** must use the gender-designated private space that corresponds with a student's primary sex designation at birth unless the student can provide an unamended birth certificate or documentation of a medical treatment or procedure that distinguishes the student's sex designation.
- **Employees** must use the gender-designated private space that correspond with an employee's primary sex designation at birth unless the employee can provide an amended birth certificate and documentation of a primary sex characteristic surgical procedure that distinguishes the employee's sex designation.
