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The study was approved by the board on Tuesday. Notes were sent home to those who are affected by the change today. Parents in this area can apply for open enrollment and will provide their own transportation to get their student to the school. We don't want students walking across 5600 W. to get to the school. It is too dangerous. These students will be bussed to West Valley Elementary starting with the 2017-2018 school year. Impact- We aren't quite sure what the impact it will have on the school. We do know that we will lose about 150 students if they don't sign up for open enrollment. We will be watching the numbers very closely.
