<p>3 aides have been hired to do reading interventions K-3. Beginning of year DIBEL's testing has started. Purchased MCLASS for the upper grades. Right now we have 804 students attending the school. If it stays that way until the October deadline, the school will get an additional .5 FTE and the TrustLand money for the P.E. specialist will be freed up to spend elsewhere.</p>
