- Reviewing the process of what the reconfiguration used to look like when the reconfiguration process started back in 2020.
- There is a new process now
- Hold an informational meeting of Fall of 2022 about October
- Packets will be put together and launched in January 2023
- Conduct a 3rd party survey
- SCC will evaluate the data from the survey
- 6th grade would then enter in Fall of 2024, if process goes through and construction complete
- Vote by summer of 2023, if the board approves
- Current 3rd graders would be the first group to enter 6th grade in the Jr. High
- If Granger Network reconfigures before Cyprus/Hunter Networks, we could have students attend Armstrong for 5th grade, their neighborhood school for 6th grade and then jr. high in their network.

- Two academic goals identified by leadership team as guided by SCC data study in the last meeting:
- Draft of goal #1
- Compared to schoolwide performance on the 2021 RISE, students' average test performance on the 2023 Math RISE will increase by 15% to a schoolwide proficiency rate of 50%. This goal will be monitored by total proficiency on Acadience Math Benchmark Assessments.
- Draft of goal # 2
- At least 68% of students will be at typical or above typical progress on the Acadience Reading POP goals for the EOY assessment. This goal will be monitored by Acadience progress monitorina.
- Review whole plan:
- Must have vs like to have analyzed when making plan
- Must be tied to academic goals
- ESSR money next year is \$125,000
- Trust Land Spending:
- Software purchases (IXL & ST Math) \$10,750
- Salaries and Benefits \$30,000
- Technology Supplies (Chromebook refresh) \$30,000
- Fund 2 full time literacy paras (+ESSR 3 Money) \$22, 500
- Literacy Night home connection for stipends and supplies \$5,000
