Item 6: Land Trust Plans

At least 72% of students will be at typical or above typical progress on the Acadience Reading POP goals for the EOY assessment.

80% of students will show typical or above typical growth in math as measured by EOY iReady diagnostic in 2024. *We will consult the iReady people to help us understand what a reasonable goal is.

At least 73% of MLL students will be at typical or above typical progress on the Acadience Reading POP goals for the EOY assessment.

By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, at least 62% of students will report that they believe they can succeed in achieving academic outcomes.

100% of grade level teams will report proficiency data on target standards on a school wide PLC data tracking tool at least monthly.

We are hoping to schedule an additional March meeting before 3/25 to review and approve the Land Trust Plan.
