5. Principal Comments
  - a. Amendment to the current Land trust plan: Due to concerns about carrying over so much money from being unable to hire additional paras, substitutes, and staff to attend professional development conferences. We have been asked to spend more of our money. With our focus on math next year, there is an intervention program called "Do the Math" that we are purchasing to support our interventions with students who struggle in math. The cost is about \$6600. The Council voted in favor of spending Land Trust money to purchase this program.
  - b. Literacy and Math summer learning programs for Bacchus students this June: The Math program will be used for 4-6<sup>th</sup> graders and the literacy program will be for K-2 graders. Teachers have already sent home notes to students they feel could benefit from the program. Students go from 6/7-7/1 M-Th for 1 hour. 30 minutes will be small group work and then 30 minutes will be with a Para support Group.
  - c. Invitations have been made and are going out this week for the 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade promotion parade. It will be Wednesday June 2, from 5:30-7pm.
  - d. Field day is June 1<sup>st</sup> and the PTA has emailed signup volunteer forms to the parents.
  - e. Staff Changes: We will be hiring several new staff members to replace those who are retiring, moving, or changing positions.
