## MINUTES NOV. 15, 2022

3. Minutes from last month's meeting approved: Cynthia & Jessica

4. Old business:

- Net Positive Assembly (Internet safety) scheduled for Feb. 3, will talk to PTA about also scheduling White Ribbon Week that same week.
- Graduate of Granite Characteristics-At school we have been adding each skill to morning announcements, and having teachers talk about them in their class. Next step is to communicate the characteristics with families. A suggestion was to send out the flier with report cards as an explanation of the skills being on the report cards for the first time. Also, send out messages via website, social media, School Dojo.

6. New Items:

- Next year's LAND Trust Budget, start thinking about it and planning:
  - Goal 1: Using Land Trust funding for a needed half-day kindergarten class allows us to implement Early Literacy Intervention (OEK) for the 2022-23 school year. We will use the KEEP Exit Assessment for our data. Bacchus will have 60% of Kindergarteners exit with Proficiency levels of 3 in Literacy and 80% of your Kindergarteners exit with Proficiency levels of 3 in Numeracy. \$34,100
  - It was suggested to talk to Kindergarten teachers about changing the measure and using Acadience growth scores, which aligns to our school-wide goals and focus. Admin will talk with them and bring information back.
  - Goal 2: Students will increase their proficiency on the Math RISE assessment in the Spring of 2023 (compared to the performance of each grade level in the Spring of 2022) by five percentage points in all grade levels. If we build time for weekly grade level PLC time focusing on effective PLC activities, data and student learning, then we will increase teacher collaboration, response to data, and increase student achievement. \$13,600. SCC will think about this and sees the value in creating PLC time for teachers.
- Safe Walking Route SCC looked at the map and had concerns with the safety of the walking route east on Loadstone Ave. There needs to be a crosswalk, on the north side of the street because students are crossing unsafely. Ave will reach out to granite PD about concerns.
