  - Last year's goals:
    - For 2022-2023 school year, Bacchus was given \$47,704 dollars and planned to pay for half Kindergarten teacher's salary which allowed us to implement Early literacy Intervention (OEK). The goal is the same as last year: 60% of students have a proficiency level 3 in Literacy and 80% of students have a proficiency level 3 in Numeracy. (33% reached level 3 in Literacy, 67% reached level 3 in Numeracy) We also plan to use funds to pay for PLC assistants to cover classes while teachers meet in weekly PLC meetings to problem solve student learning using data to guide instruction. The measurement tool will be the end of year RISE assessment and our goal is to increase our Math by 5 percentage points in 3rd-5th grades (Goal 33%). (2023 reports: 21%)
  - 2023-2024 Goals
    - Goal #1: Using Land Trust funding for a full day kindergarten class allows us to implement Early Literacy Intervention (OEK) for the 2023-24 school year. We will use the Acadience Assessment for our data. Bacchus will have 60% of Kindergarteners reach their typical or above typical progress goal (POP goal) on the End of year Acadience Reading and Math benchmark tests.
    - Goal #2 (Amend): Students will increase their proficiency on the Science RISE assessment in the Spring of 2024 (compared to the performance of each grade level in the Spring of 2023) by five percentage points in all grade levels . If we build time for weekly grade level PLC time focusing on effective PLC activities, data and student learning, then we will increase teacher collaboration, response to data, and increase student achievement.
    - Amend to: **Overall RISE Achievement:** Compared to schoolwide performance on the 2023 RISE, students' average test performance on the 2024 RISE will increase by 3% to a schoolwide proficiency rate of 25%. If we build time for weekly grade level PLC time

focusing on effective PLC activities, data and student learning, then we will increase teacher collaboration, response to data, and increase student achievement.
