4. Old business: LAND Trust 23-24
 - Amendment was approved by School Board on 3/12/24
 - We can now use the remaining funds to pay for our paraeducators, and therefore save our TSSA fund for next year.
 - "Amendment 2: Because our estimated expenditures were less than planned for both goals, we are planning to use the excess funds to pay for paraeducators. Goal #2 Improving RISE proficiency Academic area: Math, Science, ELA Action Step: We would like to use our extra funding to pay for paraeducators, who will help with small group instruction which will help teachers differentiate instruction and therefore increasing proficiency levels on the RISE tests at the end of the year."
5. New Items:
 - LAND Trust 24-25
 - State Goal #1: **All members of SCC approve and agree that this is how we should plan for next school year, including Adrienne, who was not in attendance.**
 - 8% of students who are well-below benchmark on Acadience Reading and Acadience Math at the beginning of the year will increase to below, at, or above benchmark by the end of the 2024-2025 school year.
 - Academic Areas:
 - English/Language Arts and Mathematics
 - Measurements:
 - We will use Acadience Reading and Math benchmark data to indicate success, and progress monitor with fidelity throughout the year to gauge progress.
 - Action Plan Steps and Expenditures
 - 1. We will hire paraprofessionals for small reading and math groups. (\$50,985)
 - 2. The paraprofessionals will work with small groups of students to provide reading and math intervention.
 - 3. We will have a master calendar so that we can maximize our paraprofessionals' time to help in each grade level.
