## Beehive Elementary Summary of School LAND Trust Final Report 2016-2017

Providing opportunities for our students to realize their greatest potential is our main charge at Beehive Elementary. The focus of how our LAND Trust money is spent shows our dedication to getting results that show all students are growing and progressing. The majority of our 2016-2017 LAND Trust funds were used to purchase technology for our classrooms and a classroom aide. Our classroom aide was utilized to support reading development using small groups. Professional development is vital for our teachers. A portion of our funds was used to pay for substitutes for teachers.

School achievement data shows growth in Kindergarten, third grade, fourth grade, fifth grade, and sixth grade from our beginning of year DIBELS benchmark to our end of year benchmark. It is our school's goal to meet or exceed the Utah State Office of Education's Uniform Growth Goal set forth for our school. 34% of our students in grades 3-6 were proficient on the SAGE Summative Math assessment, and 25% of our students in grades 3-6 were proficient on the SAGE Summative Language Arts assessment.

We appreciate and value the benefits of Utah's LAND Trust monies. Hiring personnel to assist teachers during small group instruction, providing time for teachers to develop professional skills, and increasing our print and digital resources have greatly benefited the students of Beehive Elementary.
