Summary report of how LAND trust funds were used last year

- Land Trust report outlined in document
- Hired 3 paraprofessionals to help with tier 2 small group
- 3 PLC assistants to cover classrooms once a week for teachers to collaborate, analyze data, and support student learning
- Funds allocated to purchase literacy instructional support for teachers to use in the classroom
 - Printables, small group supplies, programs, things to use to keep the teachers going during the tier 2 block

Report on last year's implementation and success

- Reading Acadience Screener 3 times through the year (beginning, middle, and end of year)
 - Information helped track students who are reading on, below, or well below grade level and provided information how to best support students in the tier 2 intervention groups
- Results are as follows:
 - Beginning of year:
 - At or above benchmark 17%
 - Benchmark 15%
 - Below benchmark 15%
 - Well below benchmark-54%
 - Middle of year:
 - At or above benchmark 18%
 - Benchmark 17%
 - Below benchmark 15%
 - Well below benchmark-51%
 - End of year:
 - At or above benchmark 22%
 - Benchmark 16%
 - Below benchmark 15%
 - Well below benchmark-48%

- School goal in literacy was 60% to make typical to above typical growth as measured by DIBELS Pathways of Progress report
- Combined average end of year Pathways for Progress for K-5th grades was **62**%
- Due to the POP data increase school goal was increased this year as well
- Goal for 2022-2023 school year is 66% of students will reach their POP goal
- Will continue to tailor Tier 2 support based on beginning of year DIBELS scores, then adjust these supports based upon data gathered throughout the school year
- Math goal for 2021-22 school year was to demonstrate a 3% increase on their math and science RISE proficiency in comparison to the 2020-21 school year
- Progress on this goal will be measured by comparing 2021-22 to 2020-21 RISE math proficiency percentages
 - o **2020-2021**
 - Math Overall
 - <u>19.5% proficiency</u>
 - 3rd 32%, 4th 17%, 5th 18%
 - Science Overall
 - 23.4% proficiency
 - 4th 19%, 5th 24%
 - o **2021-2022**
 - Math Overall
 - <u>25.5% proficiency</u>
 - 3rd 32%, 4th 27%, 5th 16%
 - Science Overall
 - 16.9% proficiency
 - 4th 15%, 5th 19%
- Beat math goal of increasing overall proficiency from 19.5% to 25.5%
- Increase of 6%
- Science did decrease from year before
- Will continue to monitor and adjust science instruction utilizing updated core and resources to help support student learning of various science concepts
- Will provide 4th and 5th grade students with CFA opportunities using the RISE platform
- Will give students exposure to multistep science questions and provide teachers with feedback on how students are progressing in their science learning
