Parent Permission **REQUIRED**

Dear Parents,

Bennion is excited to have a **COLOR FESTIVAL** for our 4th quarter no office referral activity! We are going to be having a sidewalk chalk party, music, and a color chalk throw! Because of the nature of this activity, parent permission will be required. Please read the below info about throwing chalk and then sign the permission form based on your preference. ALL students who have not received any office referrals during the 4th quarter can participate in the color toss, but we will offer an alternate activity that will still include a dance party and sidewalk chalk for those not interested in the color throw.

Chalk Powder Toss: Each student will be given their own packet of chalk to toss. The powder should be tossed up into the sky. It is most likely that participants will get chalk powder all over their body. We will have sunglasses for all students, but you may consider wearing a face mask if you are worried about powder getting into your nose/mouth. It is even more fun to rub the colors, into the hair, back of the neck, and cheeks! Do not throw colors directly into people's eyes or mouth. Students that intentionally throw chalk into others' face will be removed from the activity. Anyone with asthma, other breathing issues, or allergies to cornstarch should avoid the chalk powder throw.

Chalk Powder Details: The color powder we are using for the chalk throw is a high-quality cornstarch that is colored. The colored powder is non-toxic, washable, but can stain clothes and skin. This activity will be held at the end of the day, so students can get right home to clean up. Details regarding the powder can be found at https://www.purcolour.com.

Before & After Info: The color powder may stain hair & clothes, so keep that in mind when choosing your outfit for the day. White t-shirts will look the most colorful, but the colors may not wash out. Please also error on the side of caution when choosing shoes and pants for the day due to the colored corn starch. To avoid and/or minimize stain, vigorously shake out all dry excess powder before stepping into a shower or throwing clothes in the wash. Once the caked dry colors get wet, it is hard to get out. You may want to have old towels/sheets for your car seats to avoid staining when picking up your student at the end of the day.

Alternate Activity: All students without office referrals will have fun outside creating sidewalk chalk art and having a dance party. Those unable to throw chalk powder will start their dance party early, and everyone will join to create chalk art. If students have no office referrals, but do not have a signed permission slip, they will be able to participate in the dance party and sidewalk chalk. Only those with signed permission slips will be participating in the color chalk powder throw.
