

Important Information

- **COMPUTER SCIENCE GRANT:** Tomorrow Did you know Bennion is one of 10 elementary schools in Granite that have been chosen to participate in a Computer Science Grant? Each grade level has received a different robotics kit that aligns with the developmental needs of their students. By building a strong foundation of problem-solving, collaboration, and communication we are preparing our students to enter tomorrow's workforce!



- **CELL PHONES AT SCHOOL:** We want to remind students and parents that cell phones and other electronic devices are not allowed to be accessed during school hours. School rules prohibit all use of communication devices by students except for safety purposes. If students do carry a cell phone to communicate with parents before or after school, the cell phone must be turned off and stored in a backpack while on school property. Neither Granite School District nor Bennion Elementary are responsible for damage to or loss of cell phones or other personal property brought from home. Cell phones and other electronic devices will be confiscated if used during the school day and parents will need to pick them up. Items deemed by school personnel to be disruptive to the learning/safety of students will be confiscated.

- **SNOW DAY DISTANCE LEARNING INFO:** Wintertime is fast approaching, and we want to prepare our students for a Snow Day when school would be dismissed. If conditions are too hazardous for students and staff to arrive at school safely, Granite School District will call a Snow Day, and distance learning from home will take place. Bennion has decided that if there is a Snow Day is called, students will be prepared to work from home with a distance learning packet from their teacher. Last week you should have received your student's "Snow Day Packet." **This work should be kept somewhere in the house that is safe and should not be completed unless an official Snow Day is called.** If this happens emails and texts will be sent out to parents letting them know of the school closure and Snow Day. Students will be expected to complete their Snow Day Packet for distance learning and return it to their teacher the following day.
