3. Council Business Items:

Arcadia Feeder Proposal: Turned time to Steve Hogan. Steve Hogan presented the proposal to have Arcadia feed into Bennion Jr. High and then into Taylorsville. Arcadia currently feed into Bonneville and then into Cottonwood. If it was adopted by the district it would 175 students over 2-3 years. Bennion's enrollment this year is 1010. Dr. Horton explained that the biggest problem would be classrooms. They could convert computer labs to help out so that there wouldn't be a too many relocations. Laura Richin's expressed that she thought it would be a good idea and keep kids together in the community. Janalyn Hansen expressed concerns about having too many kids in the school. Dr. Horton explained that there are enough lockers and that classrooms size would remain the same. The ratio of student to teacher ratio would remain at 1:27.25 teachers to students. It would add 6 more classes. The council then discussed the possibility of future 9th grade going to high school and the 6th grade moving up to the Jr. High. Steve Hogan advised that the final decision would be in December.
