come to Bonneville. It would appear this
group in Arcadia are going to go to
Bennion regardless of the Boards
decision if Bennion will accept them. This
has not happened before but now the
boundary study has been approved the
atmosphere out in the Bennion area is
that the boundary will be approved and
parents don't want to split years in junior
high. Even if Arcadia area decides to stay
with Bonneville if Bonneville wants to
continue to offer a comprehensive junior
high model something has to be done
about the enrollment numbers. The
school administration would like to have
the reconfiguration occur as soon as
possible. If we lose programs students
will not come back.

The Council agrees to send a letter to the

begin the discussion about 6th grade
