6th grade reconfiguration Update	<p>**On April 24th Bonneville conducted an online vote to move forward with the survey. Voting results: 9 yes 0 no missing Roni Wilcox. Letter sent 4/26/2018</p> <p>Informational meeting with the Superintendent went well. Many patrons attended and good things discussed. Council feels the meeting was a success.</p> <p>Council decided to conduct email vote over the summer after reviewing the results from the survey on whether to request reconfiguration or remain the same. Community input will also be considered.</p> <p>Council members attended elementary CC meetings to help with understanding the process and importance of this decision.</p> <p>All Bonneville and Granite Park network schools voted to move forward and sent letters supporting the community survey.</p> <p>Survey result were given to council members in July. Email vote was taken on July 13 on whether to move forward with reconfiguration. Bonneville Community Council voting results: Dear Superintendent Bates and District Board Members:</p> <p>Based on the survey results and a recent vote by the community council of Bonneville Junior High, we formally request that the Granite School District Board reconfigure our school network to a 6th – 8th grade model.
