

Artwork Competition Rules

Theme

Paintings should feature the Chinese Mid-autumn Festival.

Mid-autumn Festival

Form:

Paintings must be created in physical media. Acceptable media include oil, watercolor, pastel, acrylic, Chinese painting color, Chinese ink, pen and pencil.

Paper Size:

Letter size paper. Painter's name and grade should be written on the back of the paper.

Eligibility and Jurors

Any K-12th grade student is eligible for entering the competition. A painting will be accepted for the competition as long as it reflects any aspect of the required theme. Viewers in the cultural event will be the jurors, who will vote for their favorite art pieces (each viewer can vote for 2 of their favored paintings in each age group). Two most voted paintings in each group will be selected as winners.

Due Date:

Artwork should be submitted to your assigned teachers by September 25th 2023. Elementary students to homeroom teachers, Junior High to Ms Yang; Cottonwood High to Mr Bao.

Awards

Two Winners from each grade level in elementary school. Three Winners for secondary level students.
