- Schools are looking to get rid of a letter grade
- Mid-year DIBELS data - all grades are above 60% at MOY of students at or above typical growth except kindergarten
- SAFE WALK ROUTE- is reviewed by Cindy and Renee at the start of the school year. It is linked on our school web page (SAFE WALKING ROUTE APPROVED)
- Digital Citizenship- state has a lot of suggestions, one is "common sense." Teachers can use Nearpod to teach digital citizenship. Students will be getting lessons provided to them through their social skills lessons taught each Tuesday. There are about 6-7 lessons depending on the grade level

    - We have about \$11,000 left in TSSA. The district has given us permission to hire a full time remainder of the year only contract teacher. This teacher can be used as a substitute teacher or an extra teacher to help with large grades.
    - EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN: This gets emailed to teachers throughout the year. PTA has filled bins for each class with buckets, and blankets, and tarps and bins are being added to as the year goes on. Scenarios are presented to teachers at each faculty meeting to discuss and think through procedures.
