- Full time sub was hired. Half was paid for through Land Trust and half from TSSA-She will be used to help struggling students and push in for extra support in the classroom. She will offer additional tier 2 support throughout the school. (motion to approve the amendment - APPROVED)
- Land Trust for 2020-2021 - met with the leadership team yesterday to go over goals. Goals will be the same for next year as they are for this year. We will look into hiring 2 paras per grade level for grade levels to decide how to use paras for intervention and differentiated instruction.
- ELA GOAL 75% of students at or above typical growth in DIBELS based on POP. Action plan will be that DIBELS benchmark will be given. Para professionals will be hired to help with that intervention time. Students will be monitored at least once a month and intensive students will be monitored more frequently. Upper grades will have mClass purchased to help with progress monitoring.
- MATH GOAL 65% of students will reach proficiency on Granite Benchmark Testing. Action steps will be to use paras to help with support.
- There may be TSSA money for next year that we are able to hire additional administration support, instructional coach, or another social worker.
- Motion to approve Land Trust- APPROVED
