	<a href="#">Principal's Information</a>
**	BREAKDOWN OF GRADES: Terri Roylance presented a breakdown of grades from 1 <sup>st</sup> quarter. There was discussion about recognizing students with A's with notes on their lockers. Beth Pasker was going to look into FERPA rules to see if that was possible. If not, students might be recognized by being called to the counseling center and recognized there. Discussion centered around the possibilities of backpacks being brought to class and piled in a corner (away from the door) or giving kids the privilege of keeping backpacks under their desks (and they can lose this privilege if it doesn't stay under their desk). Ms. Roylance will review the current policy with Leadership and report back to the Council on their suggestions.
