Grade Reconfiguration - Ben Horsley, Director of Communications at the district office, will work on scheduling a date for the Skyline network community to discuss grade reconfiguration. He urged community council members to help parents understand that we are in the discussion phase only and nothing has been decided. The superintendent will oversee the informational meeting. Ben will send a sample survey to the community councils for review. The council will vote yes or no to go ahead with the survey. The survey will be sent to ALL households even if there is no registered student at that residence. The sample survey will take approximately 6 weeks. The company administering the survey will present the results to the community council and then all Skyline network community councils will meet and decide whether or not to move forward with submitting a formal request for configuration. Hopefully all will be done before summer break. It will require board approval and then they will need one year to work on the logistics.
