*	<p><a href="#">Selection of Chair and Vice Chair</a>  Emily Allison was selected as Chair  Beth Pasker was selected as Vice-Chair</p>
*	<p><a href="#">Meeting Rules and Procedures</a>  Both Emily and Kim were in attendance at the Skyline Community Council Meeting this morning. They liked the Rules and Procedures that Doug Bingham handed out. One of them will get us an electronic version or hard copy of those and forward them to Teri to email to members.</p>
*	<p><a href="#">Meeting time for Community Council</a>  Last year CC meetings were the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month starting at 1:45. Meetings will continue to be held the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday but we will move to 1:30 rather than 1:45.</p>
*	<p><a href="#">Current School Data</a>  Tim Clark presented the power point of The Churchill Jr. High Current School Data again for those who were not in attendance at the last meeting. It was noted again that math is the area where our students can make the most gains to improve our overall school score.</p>
*	<p><a href="#">Learning Targets</a>  Terri went over the current Learning Target (SAGE Testing) which will cover 2014 to 2020 and beyond and compared it to the Learning Target (CRT Testing) of 2000-2013. She went over the Student Achievement Action Plan (SSAP) which is overseen by the School Leadership Team. The LAND Trust Plan was discussed. In the past few years the LAND Trust money has been used to pay for extra math. Talked about new tests. Scholastic Reading Inventory (SRI) given 3 times per year and Granite Quarterly Benchmarks (GQB) give 8 times per year. It was asked that since immediate feedback from tests is available, will students move to a higher or lower class so that all students in one class can be more on the same level. It is not happening at this time. The WRITING Test which is for 8<sup>th</sup> grade only is administrated in February. At the end of the year there is a big test for English, Math and Science. A new testing platform added this year is the UTIPS which tests Social Studies, PE, Health and Family and Consumer Science. Handouts given out for 2014 Sage Summative Testing Results, Completed LAND Trust Plan for 2013-2014 and a blank sample for the School Student Achievement Plan. The council was asked to look over the SSAP plan and submit any suggestions to Terri before the October 20 deadline.</p>
