- Churchill had highest success rate for online learners and outreach from faculty for the 4th quarter of last school year.
- Will not be renewing Shmoop. Used for mostly 6th grade last year in advisory
- Current enrollment this year is slightly above what was projected.

- Approximately 20 students changing their learning option for the 2nd quarter. Most staying the same.
- Approximately 120 students currently on Distance Learning.
- Many new permits from Salt Lake District. Unable to accept.
- New fence. Installation of a new fence on the north side of the school along Oakview. Many reports of vandalism over the summer, cars driving on the lawn, kids climbing on the roof, etc.

Counseling Center Update

- Counselors have contacted all distance learners.
- Some students struggling.
- Many parents unaware of how students are doing online. Encouraged to join the Friday Zoom meetings with teachers.

Miscellaneous

- Is there anything parents can do to help teachers.
- Will there be Reality Town for 8th grade? Postponed for now.
- Parents would like more information about the new COVID quarantine guidelines.
- COVID Dashboard the district uses is confusing. Parents would like to see previous and current numbers. Something more like what Canyons District provides.
