# GSD Board Update and Q&A with Julie Jackson

- Study done on schools and capacity. District can accommodate 80,000 students but currently have 65,000. Three more elementary schools than needed in our area. Looking at boundary policies.

- Are there any safety protocols in place to educate parents on things they can do to limit time spent on certain sites?
- Things are filtered but there are still ways of getting around them.

#### Land Trust 2020-2021

- Amend current year Land Trust budget to devote \$40,000 to the purchase of new Chrome books that will soon be out of date.

### Land Trust 2021-2022
