- DO NOT APOLOGIZE!! if you feel you messed up, just pause, start over and keep going (§)

Boys singing Audition April 26th 3-4:30

**students can leave once they have auditioned. Time may vary so plan on staying the whole time.

Singing: What does that include?

Most likely, we will bring you in to sing in groups of 3-4 on April 27th. We will teach you the song that day. If you choose not to sing that is okay! You can audition for a speaking role. You will get the speaking role audition that day.

Girls singing Audition April 27th 3-5:30

**students can leave once they have auditioned. Time may vary so plan on staying the whole time.

Singing: What does that include?

Most likely, we will bring you in to sing in groups of 3-4 on April 27th. You will be asked to sing "If Only"

If you want a lead or supporting singing role you need to prepare to sing the song "If Only" from the musical "Descendants" Song instructions:

The song is chosen for the GIRLS-"If Only" See attached lyrics and score. We will play a karaoke track for you.

Dancing AUDITION 28th 3:00-5:30

**students can leave once they have auditioned. Time may vary so plan on staying the whole time.

Some kids may want a dance role only! This would be your only audition. ALSO If you want a lead/supporting role you must come to dance auditions. We will teach you the combination that day so just bring yourself!

PRO TIPs:

- If you want a lead or supporting singing/speaking role you must practice your song many, many times in front of people before your audition so you get used to singing in front of people. Record yourself and watch for pulling on your clothes, staring off into space or any other movements that don't look natural and a part of your character. Your song should be memorized, but if not, DO NOT hide your face with your sheet music!
- ACT WHILE YOU SING and BECOME the CHARACTER you are portraying to us.
 We want to see an engaging performance!
- Do not be upset if we cut you off; it just means we have seen what we need to and doesn't mean you have done a bad job.
- After the audition- Say thank you and don't talk right away when you leave the room. We can still hear you
- We need confident people to portray these characters and if you aren't confident, "act" confident! You are coming to audition
 for a show after all!

Rehearsal/choir Information

*** Rehearsals are 3-4 days after school depending on your role. Please only audition if you plan to commit. Rehearsals would be from 3-4:30 starting in November 2021. Calendar will be coming out soon!

Monologue OPTIONAL

- If you want to show us additional acting skills along with your singing or if you are auditioning for a character the Does Not Sing, you must prepare a **1** minute monologue that represents the character you want to audition for. It can be comedic or dramatic.
- You can find monologues on the internet or from books, movies or television shows. If you're not sure how to do a monologue, research people performing a monologue on YouTube or on Google.
- ACT WHILE YOU PERFORM! You need to have your song and your monologue memorized.

IF YOU DON'T MAKE CALL BACKS - it is okay! You still might make the cut to the show! It just means we saw what we needed already!!!
