- Proficiency Growth 61.3%

**School Plan 2023-2024**

Enrollment is declining. Not just CJH, but district and state as well

- Add ELL during Advisory to give extra help to ELL students
- Increase overall proficiency to 64%, overall growth to 67%, lowest 25% growth to 67%
- Next year's enrollment = 19 teachers
