- 2) **Guest comments and questions:**
 - a) Vanessa Greenlee is a new member of the Churchill community with students at Churchill and Oakridge. She came to the meeting to learn more about the community and how she can get involved.
 - b) Trudy Jorgensen-Price, is the Holladay Library Manager. She shared that Churchill is in the zone of the Holladay Library and would like to know how the library can best partner with Churchill to serve the community.
 - i) Some of the current services include:
 - (1) a “Create Space” where there is a Coding Club, Dungeons & Dragons Club, Computers with the full Adobe suite, robots, a sound room equipped with all the necessary equipment to create a podcast, to name a few.

- 4) **Data Review**

- a) Assistant Principal Matt Schelble shared an overall look at student learning data sources used by the School Leadership Team and teacher teams to meet the needs of Churchill students.
- b) The district has adopted IReady for math instruction at the middle level. IReady comes with a suite of assessments to help teachers identify the instructional needs of students.
- c) Churchill is presently identifying students who need assistance in English, Math, and/or Science (i.e., the bottom 25%) to ensure they get the help they need when they need it. The School Leadership Team is planning with the Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) to implement in-class supports and other opportunities for students to get help.

5) District Community Council:

- a) The District Community Council is scheduled to meet 5 times this year, all meetings are from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m. Churchill's council divided up the meetings to ensure participation:

6) Career and Technical Education: This year Churchill is furthering efforts to take a focused approach to Career and Technical Education. Churchill will transition from CTE “events”, because a more sustained effort through career pathways, with an emphasis on technology and engineering, is underway.

- a) During the week of November 6th Churchill will engage in a STEM Showcase. Student projects and activities will be spotlighted all week, families will be encouraged to come into the school and learn about what their students are doing.
- b) Efforts to create more project-based learning opportunities in classrooms are underway for all courses, including Career and Technical Education.
