Understanding the Situation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Why is this a concern?• Am I keeping myself open to listening and learning?

<p>Well Informed Decisions</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What research have I done to ensure that I am making an informed decision, and what research have others done? • Am I advocating for a decision that balances my personal perspective with the whole body I represent?
<p>Working Together</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What are the foreseeable outcomes, as well as other possible outcomes? • Am I prepared to help throughout the process even if the group makes a decision that isn't my preferred approach?
