Halloween: SCC suggests that we have the regular Halloween parade on the Thursday before Halloween, in the morning. We will start now in letting parents know that they will need to check in at the office and wear a badge IF THEY GO ANYWHERE OTHER THAN THE FRONT HALL AND GYM. Parents are invited to watch the parade in the gym. Students will parade through the classrooms beginning at 8:20. It may take up to 20 minutes for the parade to reach parents in the gym. If parents can let students change out of their costumes and keep the costumes in bags or backpacks until the end of the day, that would help eliminate the congestion and chaos. If younger children need help changing, parents will have to badge and sign in. We will ask parents who stay to limit time to 10 minutes or less. Staff could set up a table in the front hall or gym. Thursday, October 30, is a short day.

Safety: reminder about drop-off and no double parking. Parents could help monitor for safety.
