Election process changes and their reasons, including current election terms

Daniel apologized for the mistakes made in our election process. Janice and Daniel were given incorrect information. They were told that the elections must be within the first 3 weeks of the year and candidates had to declare at the end of last year. The rules should have been that candidates could declare at the first of this school year.

With one candidate having moved, we now have 4 parent candidates and 4 open parent positions, so we don't need to have elections.

Report from Principle and Council Chair on status of the Music program
