SNAP – SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD ACCESS PLAN

No crossing guards at 3500 South 7200 West, nor 8000 West 3500 South. Nobody has ever seen crossing guards at 8000 West Washington Drive. Biggest needs: Montclair and Adams.

All grades 3 and up will have 1:1 Chromebook access, due to purchase from West Valley. Still need to purchase Smartboards.

All music specialists funding under Beverly Taylor Sorenson Grant, same as visual arts. Provides 2 years of visual arts, then 2 years of music, 2 years drama & dance, providing every student opportunities for each through their entire 6-year attendance. Now a 6-year grant run by the district.

Tracy Rose wants to embolden the school logo that incorporates past and future. Showed an example.
