- Continue with reading and literacy goal (K-3: 90% of students proficient on reading and literacy)
- Reading Lab continued to be utilized. Classroom teachers, not Jamie, will plan Reading Lab interventions.
- Lesson Study: To increase the efficacy of whole group instruction, teachers will plan a common lesson during PLCs. Each teacher on the team will teach the lesson as Jamie and the other members of the team watch. Classes will be covered to allow teachers the opportunity to watch their teammates. Jamie would be involved in coaching this lesson.
- Trust Land money will be used to fund the Reading Lab and pay for substitutes to cover classes while teachers do their Lesson Study. It will also fund Literacy Night and Family Center.
