Follow up with on Safety Concerns - Lt. P. Jaroscak

- Flashing lights not needed - Based on traffic study.
- No U Turn Signs - Clarification as to where it is permitted and where it is not.
- Flashing lights in school zone - If there is a crossing guard there cannot be a timer on the lights. Looking at the option of extending the time of the crossing guards to meet the needs of the school.
- In a 3.5 week time frame there were 22 citations and 21 warnings written. The average speed was 28.7 MPH while the lights were flashing (20 MPH zone). There was a combination of speeding and U Turn citations.
- As a council what are our concerns or ideas?
 - A letter from the council in support of the needs for the school.
 - Looking for more information about the flashers.
 - Signage to clarify lanes of traffic.

 - Students in grade 4-6 will increase by 3% as measured by the RISE testing.

 - Money to be spent on Substitutes, Paraeducators, Technology, and Equipment.
