Goals:

 - -Land Trust added 2 teachers in the Math department.
 - -TSSA-last year ever given.
- -People make a difference for our students/kids.

Support programs:

- -Americorps for 12th grade.
- -GEAR Up grants for 9th, 10th, & 12th grades- Not for 11th grade. In classroom help for Graduation.
- -PACE program for SLCC-scholarship- 9th grade thru 12th grade. Staying in the program the whole time, SLCC will pay for 2 years of their schooling.
- -TRIO program-no scholarship Goal setting & Field trips to Colleges.
- -United Way-outreach worker-(Program for Americorp) not paid by the school for 12th graders in danger of not graduating. In Ogden, Park City, and Granite Areas. 29 Week position and does home visits.

Biggest Concern: Failing students!!!!

- -Low to no engagement from distance learners
 - -Counselors are calling distance learners once a month.
 - -Distance learners are the %age of failing students.
 - -It was proposed to have the distance learning students to login to zoom for 30 minutes to ensure they are attending?
