Old Cottonwood Mall Area is now called Holladay Hills. This project will take 5-8 years to build out. The building that we see now is a parking garage that is encased by other buildings. They are having a hard time getting workers there. The building they are working on now will be 178 residences and it will take 1 1/2 years to build out. There are already 2 other Blocks approved to build. Probably in the next year there will be 5-8 blocks ready to build. (a block is what they call it in their phasing plan and how they are doing permits)
