KUDO "Star" Students

- Each week teachers nominate one student from the grade level that deserves a KUDO (good news personal letter written home to parents about their child and the specific things that child has done that is wonderful)
- Students are then the "Crestview Stars" and recognized on the CBS News, given a certificate, and get to place a star with their name on it on the bulletin board for the year.

- Individual

- Nominate students and state specifically why they earn the "Star" award.

- Principal writes a personal "Thank You" card to parents thanking them for their wonderful child and the wonderful things their child is doing!
