- 3. Reviewed budget –funds allotted, how funds used, funds that carried over. We are on target for our budget and look to have about a 5% carryover for next year. In the future, we will be looking more in depth on student numbers/ needs to decide the number of teachers in each grade level.
- 6. There is a new *Council Membership Form* which we signed showing we were present and discussed the plan for next year.
- 7. District is now pushing out a statewide app called SafeUT. It is geared for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students and older, but for all students, if needed. It creates anonymity in disclosing problems. There will be information given out at during our NetSmartz assembly to 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students.
