TOPIC 5A	UHSAA Decision on East High/Timpview High		
DISCUSSION	<p>Fourth seed granted, no forfeits (4 ineligible athletes). Region VI sanction issued. EOC reviewed with Timpview High School (1 athlete ineligible). East forfeited 7 games, no state play-offs. Cyprus moved to 4th seed by default. Play scheduled for 10/23/12 to play Region VIII Mountain View High School. Appealed to BOT. Decision overruled. BOT sympathy swayed reversal. Cyprus was reported as not wanting to go to play-offs. In the appeal, A.D. Kathy Butler from East resigned. Colossal problems! BOT applied new ruling inconsistent with Timpview forfeit of 3 games, probation for 3 years, outside auditor, coach put on probation and fined \$1,500 per player. Hess requested the district attorney to review. Dr. Bates responded that injunction petition is dead because rationale was provided regardless of appropriateness.</p>

TOPIC 5B	9 – 12 Grade Configuration	
DISCUSSION	GSD is petitioning now. Benefits to Cyprus would be access to advanced classes, counselor tracking, athletics. A lengthy process – need full community support. Board advice: Lots of logistics, how do we know if the community supports this. Issues: Bussing, mixing grades, maturity, social pressure. But academics for 9 th grade tracking will give better counseling support, increase campus size, and build up band program. Community needs the facts. Very minimal preliminary conversations with principals of the junior highs have been held. Proposing/voted – Pursuing a study available. Option for 9 th grade center. All in favor of proceeding with this option to conduct a study.
