

Community Council meeting 2/8/22

Rob McDaniel conducting meeting.

In attendance was Anne Easton, Linda McGrath, Emily Baran, Thomsen, Ana Palomar, David Mckenzie, Rob McDaniel, Monika Andreason.

Rob asked Community Council if they approve the minutes for January. Emily motioned to approve and community unanimously approved.

Rob opened the meeting for questions/comments.

-Ana Palomar suggested to have a group of teachers dedicated to English Language Learners. She sees students leaving Cyprus because they don't understand anything in their classes.

-Attend class and arrive on time.
