## Pirate Medallion

Cyprus High School has a large and diverse student body consisting of students with many talents and abilities. The Pirate Medallion is to encourage and challenge students to be involved in a wide variety of areas while attending Cyprus. We promote students who are well rounded and have participated in many areas while at Cyprus. Only 50 points will be accepted within any category. The Medallion rewards participation and not necessarily achievement. Students may apply during their senior year. It is the student's responsibility to pick up an application from the main office and to return it to the Cyprus Main Office by May 6. Late applications will not be accepted. Medallions will be awarded at the Senior Awards Banquet in May.

A student must earn a minimum of $\mathbf{2 0 0}$ points to qualify for this award. Points can accumulate from $9^{\text {th }}$ through 12th grade. The following point values apply to each year of participation at Cyprus High School. Activities done at other schools will not be accepted.

## Academics (50 max)

AP Classes ( 2 per class); AP Test ( 3 per test taken); Concurrent Enrollment Classes (1 per class per semester); GTI Courses (1 per class); CTE Pathway Completer ( 5 pts. per pathway completed); Honor Roll- 3.7 or higher ( 2 pts per quarter); 3.0-3.9 GPA (1 pt per quarter); Score 30 or higher on ACT (5 pts); Sterling Scholar- Application (1 pt), School Sterling Scholar (5 pts), Sterling Scholar Finalist (7 pts); National Merit Semi-Finalist/Finalist (10 pts), Academic All-State (5 pts/sport)

## Citizenship (50 max)

Fewer than 5 absences per year ( 5 pts ); Fewer than 8 tardies per year ( 4 pts ); 3.0 CPA (1 pt. per term); Perfect attendance- no absences, no tardies ( 5 pts per term); No Discipline Referrals ( 2 pts per year)

## Leadership/Service (50 max)

Running for Class or Student Body Office (1 pts per election); Student Body Officer (4 pts); Class Officer (4 pts per year); LIA Officer (4 pts per year); Club Officer or Team Captain (2 pts per club/sport per year); School Committee ( 2 pts per year); Tutor to other students ( 3 pts per year); Interpret for School (1 pt per event), Volunteer in Cyprus Food Pantry (1 pt per hour, max $5 \mathrm{pts})$

## Membership (50 max)

National Honor Society ( 3 pts per year); Club Membership ( 3 pts per club per year); Athletic team membership ( 3 pts per sport per year); Team Manager (3 pts per sport per year); Activity Membership- Drama, Music, Debate, Yearbook, Stage Crew, etc. ( 2 pts per membership per year)

## Performance ( 50 max)

CTE Competition-VICA, DECA, FCCLA, etc. ( 2 pts per competition, 6 max); Art show, science fair, or Battle of the Bands participant (3 pts per event); C-Factor audition (1 pt), C-Factor Finalist (3 pts); Participation in school musical or play (3 pts); Cheerleader, Drill Team, Dance Company, Band, Orchestra, Jazz Band, Improv, Vocal Music (4 pts per year per group); Debate Tournaments ( 1 pts per tournament, 5 max )
