

## Community Council Meeting Minutes September 4, 2019

Meeting Convened – 4:46 pm

In Attendance: Monica Thayer, Lisa Whiting, Stacy Brown, Melissa Zimmer, Angie Rasmussen & Angie Gavin.

-March meeting minutes were approved by all council members. Melissa moved to accept the motion and Stacy second the motion for the approved meeting minutes.

-To publicize last year's successes and this year's goals we need to wait for data to be released from the state. With the testing last year having so many challenges the data is not finalized yet. What we do know is that Science proficiency scores at Diamond Ridge are up, Reading looks fantastic (with an 85% goal we hit 89%) and we are holding steady in Math. Monica said to look for a school progress video on the Diamond Ridge website, which will be coming soon.

-Declaration of Candidacy is due and there are no candidates at this time. Monica, Stacy and Melissa will be looking for two of people to help them out. Serving on the SCC is really easy, 1 hour a month (typically 4 to 5 times per year).

-SCC elections are not necessary this year due to no candidates. Please apply today if you are interested.

-Final staffing plan for the 2019-2020 School Year was a go with the interventionist. Enrollment has been reported at 740 students, which means all teachers are staying and we have an interventionist. We will not be losing any staff this fall.

In August it came to our attention that the Jr. High Schools are struggling a bit with low enrollment due to the 9<sup>th</sup> graders going to the high school. They are looking for information on a 6<sup>th</sup> grade reconfiguration. Monica and Lisa sent a letter to Superintendent Dr. Bates requesting more information. A letter will be going out to all areas of Kearns asking families to take a survey on how people are feeling about the reconfiguration. On Wednesday, September 18, 2019, the Kearns network will be holding a "Reconfiguration Meeting" at Kearns High School. Please join us for an informational meeting about grade reconfiguration proposal in the Kearns network. Please note that no official design has been made to reconfigure at this time. However, your participation and feedback are a vital component to the process.
